Skate UK Passport – NISA Level 10
Rules

1. All competitors must be members of Blackburn Skating School. Skaters who have not paid their Blackburn Skating School membership at the time of the draw will not be entered into the draw and therefore will be unable to participate in the competition.
2. The competition timetable will be put on the notice board and the website after the closing date.
3. Age and Test Standard are as at closing date. If test standards should change before the closing date notification to Blackburn Skating School is required immediately.
4. Unless entry forms are fully completed, they will be returned to the sender for completion and re-submission before the closing date. Only written entries will be accepted. Entry fees are as detailed on the entry form. **Payment must be enclosed with entry form and no entries after the closing date will be accepted.**
5. In the event of over-subscription, entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Reserve lists will operate up until the time of the draw. Entry fees will be returned to unsuccessful entrants after the closing date.
6. Blackburn Skating School reserves the right to cancel, combine or split competitions into subsections.
7. The draw for the order of skating will be held at Blackburn Ice Arena at a date to be notified.
8. Winners of competitions shall sign for trophies on receipt and return them to the club trophy steward in good condition when requested.
9. A presentation night will follow the 3rd round of the competition and **NOT** take place on the competition night
10. All music must be on **mini disc only** and clearly marked with the name of the competitor, competition number and length of programme.
11. If anyone wishes to video or take photographs of their **own** child they must obtain a permit from A Blackburn Skating School Committee Member (a nominal charge of £1 will be payable on the day). There will be a specified area assigned for this purpose. **REMEMBER – NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY.** Cameras including mobile phone cameras may not be used in the changing areas.
12. NO STILL PHOTOGRAPHY OR VIDEOING OF THE JUDGES IS ALLOWED
13. The committee reserve the right to confiscate any offending equipment until the end of the competition
14. PLEASE NOTE THAT EVEN IF NISA TESTS ARE TAKEN BETWEEN ROUNDS SKATERS ENTER ROUND 2 AND ROUND 3 AT THE SAME LEVEL THEY ENTERED ROUND 1
